- The schedule presumes the top 2 seeded groups in each group qualifies for the Super 8.

- Super 8 games are not dependant on the final group table. E.g. England will be D2 regardless of whether or not they top their group at the end of the group stage.

- If the third seeded team in a given group qualifies for the Super 8, they will take the designation of the team that does not make it through.

E.g. If Bangladesh is ousted after the group stage, Australia will carry the designation A2 and will play the games as scheduled above.
